You are being forced to graduate from a weak, codependent civilian into a highly decorated, militant guardian of your own soul.

Number 6: The Exhumation of the Mirror (What You Hate in Them Exists in You)

This is the most terrifying, deeply uncomfortable, and absolutely ego-annihilating truth of the unremoved person.
