

# Why Jesus Stayed Silent When They Hurt You

The silence forces you into the absolute, crushing realization that every single human being on earth is capable of catastrophic failure. You must drop the heavy armor of your earthly expectations. God stayed quiet so that you would finally hit rock bottom, realize that the ground is entirely made of shifting sand, and violently anchor your soul exclusively to the unshakeable rock of Jesus Christ.

## Number 3: The Militant Restraint of the Supreme Court (Dropping the Gavel)

When someone maliciously destroys your reputation or profoundly abuses your trust, the human ego immediately climbs onto the judgment seat.
